Yes/No Would one be found guilty of spiritual adultery if he or she was trying to live under the Old Testament and New Testament at the same time?

Yes/No If we live under the New Testament should we be following the 10 Commandments and Old Law?

Yes/No Is it possible that Jesus carried most of the 10 commandments over to the New Testament?

Yes/No Does Paul indicate that we do not have an excuse for acknowledging the existence of God (Romans 1:20).

Yes/No Read Hebrews 11:6. According to the book of Hebrews, must a person have faith in order to be saved?

Blind leap/ Based on Evidence Should our faith be a blind leap or based on evidence?

Yes/No Romans 10:17 Does the Bible indicate we obtain faith by watching television?

What do you think faith is?

Yes/No In the account of Phillip and the Ethiopian Eunuch in Acts 8:26-40, does the Bible say “Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture [Isaiah 53:7-8], preached Jesus to him.”

Yes/No Are you “hearing” about God and Jesus Christ in this study?

John the Baptist preached that people should “Repent” (Matthew 3:2). Read Luke 13:3.

What does repent mean?

Yes/No Repentance is simply saying you are sorry.

Yes/No Do you believe the Bible teaches that one must repent of their sins in order to be saved?

Yes/No In the account of Phillip and the Ethiopian Eunuch, did the Eunuch confess that Jesus was the Son of God (Acts 8:37).

Yes/No Read Matthew 10:32. Did Jesus say that whoever confesses Him before men He will confess before His father in heaven?

What do you think it means to confess?

Yes/No Does the Bible teach that someone must confess in order to be saved?

Yes/No Look at Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 1 Peter 3:21. Does God’s inspired Word teach that one must be baptized in order to be saved?

Yes/No Does the Bible teach that without the shedding of blood there is no remission of sins (Hebrews 9:22)?

Leviticus 17:11 teaches that the life of the flesh is in the blood, and that blood makes atonement for the ____?

True/False Hebrews 10:4 The blood of bulls and goats can take away sins.

True/False According to 1 Peter 1:18-20, man is redeemed not by blood and silver, but by the blood of Jesus Christ.

However, Jesus died about 2000 years ago. So how do you think a person could come into contact with the blood of Jesus Christ today?

(Romans 6:3-5; Colossians 2:12).

Yes/No According to Romans 6:3-4, is baptism a burial?

True/False Baptism washes away sin (Acts 22:16).

Look at Matthew 16:18 and Ephesians 1:22-23.

What do you think is the meaning of “church” and “body” in the context of these two Scriptures?

Building/Group of people Is the church a building or a group of people?

Yes/No Did Jesus indicate He was going to build a church?

Yes/No Does it sound possessive, like this church would belong to Him?

Yes/No If the church belongs to Jesus, should it bear the name of men? (i.e., Luther, Wesley, etc.)

**Join the church/
The Lord adds you** Read Acts 2:47. How do you get into the church?

Yes/No Look at Matthew 15:13. Do churches that Christ did not build belong to Him?

Before/ After Does the Lord add you to the church before or after you obey the plan of salvation?

Yes/No Do you think Jesus would be pleased if you remained a part of a church that He did not build?

Discuss: Why do you think there are so many different denominations and do you think this pleases God?

Look at John 17:20-23. What was Jesus praying for?

Read Matthew 26:26-29; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26; Acts 20:7

Yes/No The early church met on a regularly basis to encourage one another and continue growing. Do you think Christians today need encouragement and to continue to grow?

Yes/No Did the church mentioned in those passages met each first day of the week to take the Lord's Supper?

Yes/No Do you think we should pattern ourselves after them?

Yes/No The 1st Century church met in one another's homes, ate together, and had all things in common. Do you think Christians today should only spend an hour per week together with their Christian family?

Entertain/teach the Word of God Should sermons be preached to entertain or to teach the Word of God?

Yes/No Read Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16-17. Do these passages indicate the Christians would sing together?

Yes/No Do these Scripture indicate we should use musical instruments (i.e., pianos, drums)?

Yes/No Does the Bible indicate we are to weep and rejoice together? (Romans 12:15)

Yes/No Read Acts 2:42. Did the Christians in the 1st Century church pray together?

Same/From the Heart Do you think prayers should all sound alike and be the same or do you think prayers should come from the heart of the person praying?

Yes/No Read 1 Corinthians 16:1-2. Did Christians give to their local congregation according to this Scripture?

Ultimately who owns everything?
